ParentVue The U.S. Department of Education
provides funding to our school division based on
Impact Aid survey data, which is used for general
purposes benefitting all schools. IMPACT AID is a
federal education program that reimburses school
districts for lost revenue and additional costs due to
the presence of nontaxable federal property (such as
military installations, Indian lands, national parks,

national laboratories, and Veterans Affairs hospitals).

What are the funds used for? Impact Aid, like revenue generated by taxes, can be used for any general fund purpose, such as instructional materials, teacher salaries, transportation, technology, social-emotional supports or facilities. All decisions on how Impact Aid funds are spent are made by school district leaders and locally elected school boards. This flexibility and local control ensure funds are targeted to where the greatest needs exist.
