Before we start our normal PTO business, I like to thank everyone for joining us tonight for this in-person meeting, we greatly appreciate your support. This school year there will be hybrid meetings (some in-person and virtual), please check the PTO Portal regularly for meeting schedules and updates. We are starting off the year with lot of activities, our very first is the "Sweet and Social/Bingo Night" that will be held on Thursday, September 15, 2022: 6:30-8:00 PM. A sign-up genius was distributed seeking volunteers. Please sign up, this is one of many opportunities to support and start earning volunteer hours. Our PTO PORTER website is still under new updates due to the transition of servers, county school wide. I regularly send out the PTO newsletter on Fridays with upcoming activities and updates, so please monitor your emails as those notices will have important updates/reminders of all school activities. Another activity that's quickly approaching is the "Fall Festival" that will be held on Saturday, October 15, 2022: 11:00AM-1:00 PM. A sign-up genius will be distributed for volunteers, please take advantage of this opportunity to come out and support but also earn some volunteer hours. It's a lot of fun and it will be held here at PORTER outside in the bus circle area. Tonight, we will also have a guest speaker which will be introduced during New Business. I will also discuss all New Business topics at that time. Finally, we will have a Q&A session at the conclusion so feel free to ask any questions that you may have.

Treasurer Report: Ms. Latosha Brown. Our current balance is \$2,901.00. This balance includes roll over funding from the previous school year 2021-2022.

Principal's and Teacher's Report: Ms. Foor. Good evening! I'm Ms. Foor, the proud principal for 17 years. I truly enjoy every moment of my tenured time as the principal here at Porter. The best part is getting to know everyone (students/parents) spanning over 8 years. I've gotten to know some families 16+ years due to multiple students having attended PORTER. I'm very delighted to say that we had smooth new school year opening, so thank you for all your support and cooperation, especially with the car line – the students are getting settled very well. We're now transitioning the focus to routines (rules, etc.) for the students as well as starting baseline testing. The Virginia Growth Assessments (VGA) is where all PWCS students in 3rd-8th grades will be assessed in reading and math this fall and winter. This was VA Board of Education adopted this program to help track the progress in the Standards of Learning (SOL). Testing will be conducted in three phases (1st – Beginning of school, 2nd – middle of school year and 3rd – end of the school year). The regular SOL testing will still be conducted in the spring. The VGA will be taken

onsite at school and at the conclusion of the test window, your student's will be provided with a report of their performance. For more information, information was disseminated on Thursday, September 1st in the PORTER September eUpdate. Also, there will be an option during these communications to provide feedback as we will use this tool to make informed decisions. If you are not receiving the eUpdates, please contact the front office, Ms. Michele.

Our first back to school night will be next week for Middle School on Tuesday, September 13, 2022, 6:30-7:30 PM. The Elementary Back to School Night will be on Thursday, September 29, 2022, during two separate sessions to accommodate everyone. 1st-3rd will be 6:30-7:15PM and 4th-5th will be 7:30-8:15PM. This was also included on the eUpdate and it will be posted on the Porter website and Canvas. From Ms. Chapman, the staff was very appreciative and thankful for the \$100 gift cards provided by the PTO. Each staff member received a \$100 gift card to help them with the purchase of any additional supplies they may need – Thank you very much for supporting them.

Volunteer opportunities are up and running. It's great to have everyone back in the building helping and supporting the school. Start on your hours early and be sure to periodically check the PORTER Volunteer webpage for opportunities. As opportunities fill quickly, please be sure to notify Ms. Pat or Ms. Michele if you can't make your signed day, this will allow others to sign up. We understand life happens and sometimes you cannot make it, however, please be sure to notify the front office. Remember, you can donate water and this year we will have another donation opportunity for our "PORTER Day of the Arts", we are seeking recycling materials (bowling balls, hub caps, etc.). If you are doing some fall/garage cleaning, please drop off items at the school.

Our PORTER website is going through a transition, which will be standard communication going forward. It will not provide specific classroom/teacher related information. I encourage you to sign up for parentVue and Canvas so that you will have access to your student's specific progress and the most updated classroom information. There will be a parent tech night on Thursday, October 6, 2022. Our Book Fair will also be held that night, so please come out and join us.

Transportation – I know our car line can be very long at times, I kindly ask that you continue to use your star quality of patience and understanding following the car line procedures. If you are in the car line before 9:00 AM, your student will not be marked late/tardy. If you are in the car line after 9:00 your student will be marked late/tardy. We have system in place to closely monitor. As such you will regularly see Ms. Michele monitoring the car line.

Field Trips – Typically each grade participates in 2-3 field trips. We will resume as early as October 2022. Due to rising costs (gas) most, field trips will be local and Charter buses will be eliminated. We will do local field trips this year and have some great resources that we can leverage. There will be volunteer opportunities for field trips, and it will be a Lottery. If not selected during the lottery you can still drive to the location. You won't earn volunteer hours, just inform the teacher that you plan to drive. Ms. Foor supplemented a lot of the field trips; however, the costs have risen significantly (\$80-90/ per student).

Finally, we want to continue to promote extra-curricular activities, last year a group of parents started a soccer club on Friday's, and it was a success. The 1st graders enjoyed it. So, if you are interested in
